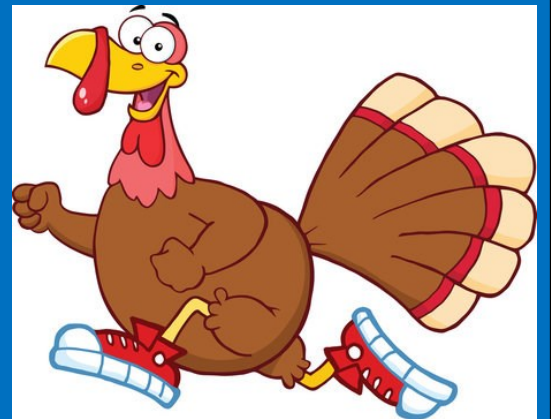

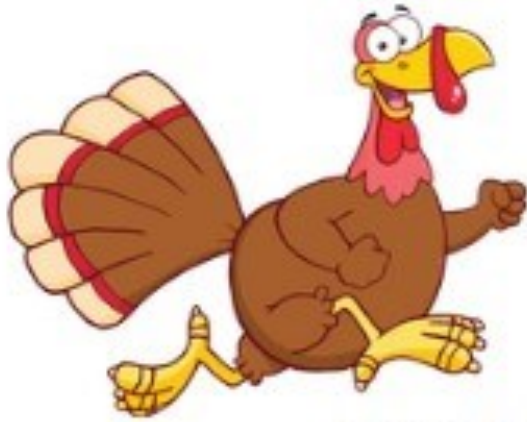

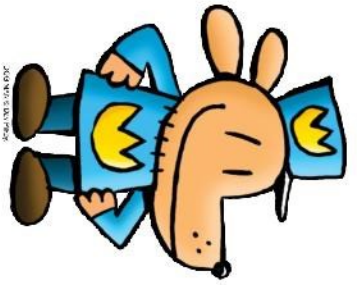

Teacher Wish Lists will be available. Please consider purchasing a book for your child's classroom.

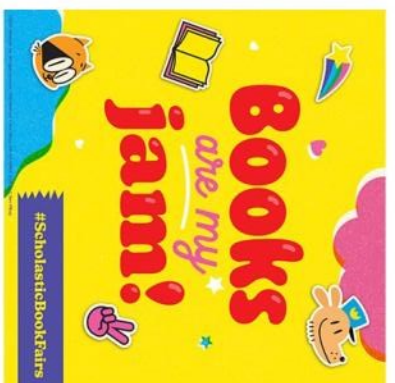
