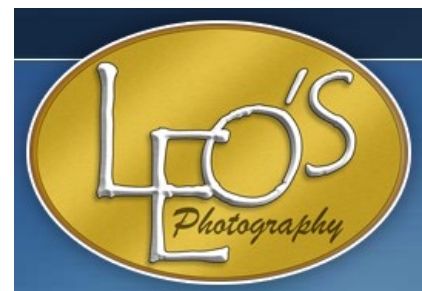

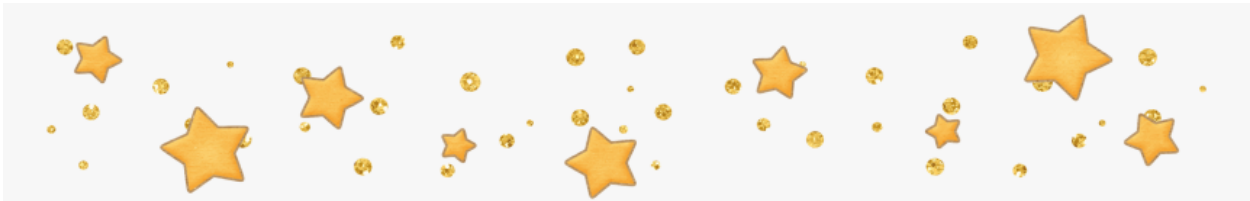

From the Library

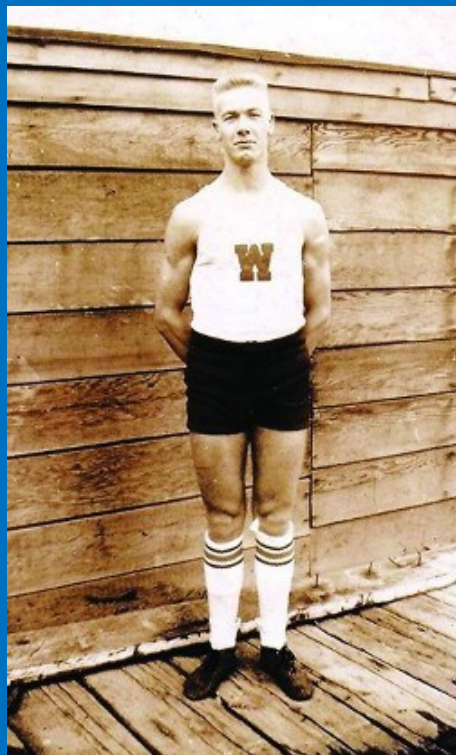
The Free Bookshelf in the Helen Haller library is nearly empty! Our students have loved discovering the books we've provided on this shelf.
